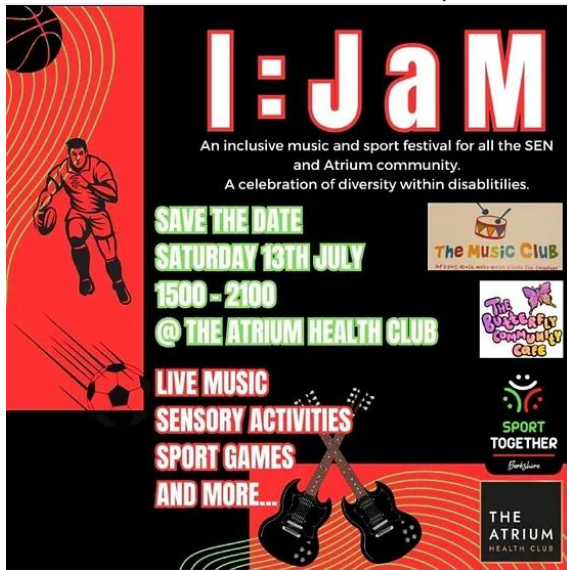

All of these activities can be adapted to suit the needs of SEND children, our instructors have experience working with SEND children and would be happy to adjust the activity accordingly.</p>
